
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MEMORANDUM FOR Commanders, Leaders, Staff and Employees; and Civilian Human Resources Agency Personnel

SUBJECT: Implementing Guidance for Workers' Compensation under Federal Employees' Compensation Act (FECA)

1. Reference Assistant G-1 for Civilian Personnel Implementing Guidance for Workers' Compensation under the Federal Employees Compensation Act (FECA), April 2013 (superseded by the enclosed Update 2).
