SUBJECT: Army Consistency Review of Classification of Criminal Investigator Series 1811 Positions and Evaluation for Special Retirement Coverage Eligibility

2. The purpose of this memo is announcement of an Army-wide review of Criminal Investigator position descriptions (PDs) classified to the 1811 series directed by ASA(M&RA). This review is consistent with Civilian Workforce Transformation efforts to align positions with organizational mission, function, placement in the appropriate civilian career program, and promotion of professional development. The purpose of the review is to ensure that Army classification of positions in the 1811 series is consistent with Office of Personnel Management (OPM) classification standards and to assess which positions may be eligible for special retirement coverage (SRC).
3. References, evaluation criteria, and submission guidance are provided in Enclosures 1, 2 & 3. A spreadsheet of each command's employees currently assigned to series 1811 and associated PD numbers has been filed to an AKO collaboration page.
