SUBJECT: Request for a Continued Exception to Policy Eliminating the Requirement for Nonappropriated Fund (NAF) Human Resources Offices (HROs) to Notify Supervisors When NAF Employees Annual Performance Ratings and Probationary Ratings Are Due

1. This responds to your memorandum dated 2 November 2015 request for a continued exception to Army Regulation (AR) 215-3, paragraphs 1-4.k.(5) and 6-4.c., eliminating the requirement for Nonappropriated Fund (NAF) Human Resources Offices (HROs) to notify supervisors of when NAF employees' annual performance ratings and probationary ratings are due.
2. Your request for an extension is approved until AR 215-3 Rapid Action Revision is published. We intend to revise AR 215-3, paragraphs 1-4.k.(5) and 6-4.c. consistent with this exception. The responsibility to administer the personnel performance evaluation program still resides with the NAF HRO.
