

SUBJECT: Extension of Delegated Examining Authority – Southwest Civilian Personnel
Operations Center, Fort Riley, Kansas, DD-AR-002

This responds to your memorandum of April 7, 2005, requesting a two-year extension of delegated examining authority for the Delegated Examining Unit (DEU), Southwest Region Civilian Personnel Center (CPOC), Fort Riley, Kansas. A review of Southwest Region Civilian Personnel Operations Center conducted by this office in February 2005 revealed that the delegated examining unit is functioning in accordance with instructions provided by the Department of Defense, and that procedures contained in the U.S. Office of Personnel Management (OPM) Delegated Examining Operations Handbook are being followed. On this basis, the delegated examining authority for Southwest Region CPOC is extended until May 6, 2007, as shown in the attached delegation, unless terminated earlier. Your next Staff Assistance Visit (SAV) is tentatively scheduled for February 2007.

Under this authority, delegated examining may be conducted for all Administrative Careers With America (ACWA) examinations effective February 3, 2003. A copy of that delegation is attached to this memorandum and outlines the parameters under which your delegated examining unit may exercise that authority. This authority does not include Administrative Law Judge positions. OPM will continue to support competitive examining requirements for these positions.


Positions covered: All serviced positions. This delegation does not include Administrative Law Judge positions.
