SUBJECT: Army Civilian Cyberspace Workforce Coding

1. References:

a. Department of Defense Directive 8140.01, 11 August 2015, subject: Cyberspace Workforce Management

b. Memorandum, Department of Defense Chief Information Officer, 27 February 2014, subject: Coding of DoD Cyberspace Workforce Positions.

2. As Army continues to build and enhance the capabilities of the total force, we are simultaneously developing a process to strategically manage the Army Civilian cyberspace workforce with the goal of unifying the workforce and establishing specific cyberspace workforce elements (cybersecurity, cyberspace effects, cyberspace information technology (IT), and intelligence (cyberspace)) to align, manage and standardize cyberspace work roles, baseline qualifications, and training requirements, reference 1a.

3. This memorandum directs the review and coding of Army Civilian personnel and positions performing cyberspace work roles. Position coding provides the baseline to build viable career management solutions and enhance training to develop a ready cyberspace workforce. Note: The review and coding of Defense Civilian Intelligence Personnel System (DCIPS) positions and personnel in support of cyberspace operations will not commence until the Under Secretary of Defense for Intelligence issues cyberspace coding guidance for DCIPS positions and personnel.

4. The coding of the cyberspace work roles is consistent with the Office of Personnel Management directed coding of the Occupational Series 2210, Information Technology Specialist accomplished in 2014, reference 1b.

5. The Office of the Assistant G-1 for Civilian Personnel will distribute Army-specific coding instructions to all activities not later than 31 December 2015.
