### Appendix D CP 20 Phase II Intern Training Plan

After successfully completing Phase I formal training and Phase II on-the-job training, Interns will be able to:

<b>TASKS</b>	<b>SKILLS, KNOWLEDGE and ABILITIES</b>
<b>1. Orientation</b>	Define the organization structure and mission of the Quality Assurance Organization
<b>2. Forms and reports</b>	Prepare and maintain ammunition forms, reports, correspondence and automated system documents. Maintain and revise Ammunition Data Cards, (ADC's) and Depot Surveillance Records (DSR) cards. Determine adequacy of technical references (publications, drawings, etc.) in the branch office.
<b>3. Shipping</b>	Inspect motor vehicle prior to and after loading with ammunition. Inspect explosive-laden railcars. Inspect empty railcars and be able to certify as acceptable for carrying various classes of ammunition.
<b>4. Explosive</b>	Safety Prepare recommendations for waiver of explosive safety standards. Inspect ammunition storage and handling operations. Perform inspection and test of lightning protection systems and static grounds. Review site plans.
<b>5. Area Operations</b>	Prepare ammunition test samples for shipment. Select surveillance inspection samples. Perform surveillance function test and destroy duds by detonation (where applicable). Perform or verify storage monitoring operations. Inspect storage facilities and structure for defects.
<b>6. Maintenance</b>	Determine requirements for ammunition peculiar equipment (APE) and test, measuring and diagnostic equipment (TMDE). Inspect ammunition maintenance/renovation operations and facilities. Perform in-process verification inspection. Use and maintain precision measuring instruments. Determine maintenance operations equipment pre-test and post-test requirements. Monitor the accomplishment of DA modification work orders.
<b>7. Stockpile Surveillance</b>	Inspect ammunition items and components and prepare ammunition surveillance inspection reports. Maintain ammunition suspension and restriction/release file.
